Opportunity to extend opportunity throughout the academic year, with modified hours, pending additional funding.

Who should apply: A youth or youth-worker who is self- motivated and able to build trusting relationships with other young people as well as a demonstrated capacity to communicate with and work alongside adult allies. Individuals who have experience in co-ops and/or supporting youth to run a cooperative business, find their agency, and work to fight local and global injustices, and are passionate about mentoring peers. Current members of WYC or similar organizations are encouraged to apply. Bilingual a plus.

- Accompanying youth on trips to events and cooperative visits
- Supporting youth on research and documentation of their co-op
- Connect with local community organizers and schedule workshops and other experiences for youth.
- Participate in staff collective meetings and support other areas of programming as needed.
